## PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR HOUSE NUMBER IS VISIBLE FROM THE STREET IN CASE EMERGENCY PERSONNEL NEEDS TO FIND YOU.

\*\* PET LICENSES ARE PAST DUE. Pets must be licensed EVERY YEAR by May 1<sup>st</sup>. The cost of the license is \$10.00 for dogs and \$3.00 for cats that are spayed/neutered and \$5.00 for cats that are not spayed or neutered. There is a limit of 3 dogs and 3 cats per residence. Please license your pets ASAP. Also, chicken permits are required annually. The permit cost is \$1.00. IT IS THE PET OWNERS' responsibility to keep their pet off other people's property whether it's a dog or cat. DO NOT let your pet defecate on others property or on the sidewalk (chapter 3 article 2 section 2-213). PLEASE, CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET.

**\*\* COMMENTS, CONCERNS, and COMPLAINTS:** Please call the Village Office 402-665-2391 if you have any comments, concerns or complaints. Or go to <u>www.cerescone.com</u> and click on Comments, Concerns, Complaints button and fill out the form and click submit. Please allow 72 hours for a response.

\*\* **COVENANT COMMUNITY FOOD PANTRY:** Is a food program for ANYONE in the community. It will be held the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays each month from 9:00 ó 10:00 A.M, at the Evangelical Covenant Church 208 W Pine. Enter through the East door and come to the kitchen. Local delivery available. If you have questions please call 402-785-5455 or 402-890-9850 and leave a message. They will get back to you.

**\*\* SENIOR DINER:** Ceresco 60+ serves lunch every Wednesday at noon in the Community Building. Please note that if school is canceled due to weather there will not be senior diner. New members are always welcome.

\*\* COMPOST SITE: DUE TO VIOLATIONS - A gate has been placed across the entrance of the compost site. You will only be able to use the compost site when the gates are open from 8:00 am ó 8:00 pm. Times are subject to change. The compost site is not a dump or a landfill and CANNOT be treated like one. Do not leave trash bags at the compost site. It is a collection site for tree branches and grass clippings only. Absolutely NO lumber may be left at the compost site. Make sure to keep the piles separate. (Tree branches in the tree pile/grass in the grass pile.) Citations may be issued because we are at risk of losing it. Please contact the Village Office if you see any illegal dumping. A description of the vehicle and a license plate number would be a big help. The Compost site is open to Ceresco Water users only. PLEASE DO NOT DRIVE IN THE COMPOST SITE WHEN IT IS MUDDY.

PLEASE NOTE! THE RECYCLING CONTAINERS IN THE MAINTENANCE YARD ARE FOR CERESCO UTILITY CUSTOMERS ONLY!

\*\* **CARDBOARD:** The dumpster at the Village Maintenance Shop is for **CARDBOARD ONLY**. Please <u>break down</u> boxes. No carpet or other items allowed.

\*\* METAL: The metal box is for METAL ONLY. No mattresses, couches or other trash. The dumpsters will be removed if violations continue. THE DUMPSTERS ARE FOR VILLAGE RESIDENTS ONLY.
