**** WATER RATES CHANGE:** The second phase of Ordinance 2018-1 takes effect July 2019 to help pay for the well maintenance program. Water rate increase will be reflected on the August utility bill.

**** BACK TO SCHOOL REMINDER:** With school starting soon **PLEASE** drive carefully and obey the speed limit, and watch for children crossing the street. Children will be excited and might not remember to watch for you! **DO NOT pass school busses when the stop arm is out** and children are loading and unloading. Law enforcement will be in town monitoring school traffic at unscheduled times. Please remind your driving age children as well.

**** REMINDER** Please make sure your house number is visible from the street in case emergency personnel need to get to you.

**** PET LICENSES ARE PAST DUE.** Pets must be licensed **EVERY YEAR** by May 1st. The cost of the license is \$10.00 for dogs and \$3.00 for cats that are spayed/neutered and \$5.00 for cats that are not spayed or neutered. There is a limit of 3 dogs and 3 cats per residence. Please license your pets ASAP. Also, chicken permits are required annually. The permit cost is \$1.00. **IT IS THE PET OWNERS'** responsibility to keep their pet off other people's property whether it's a dog or cat. **DO NOT** let your pet defecate on others property or on the sidewalk (chapter 3 article 2 section 2-213). **PLEASE, CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET.**

**** MOSQUITO REMINDER:** Mosquitos carry the West Nile Virus. Ways to reduce risk of exposure are to apply insect repellent, cover up by wearing long sleeve shirts, long pants and socks sprayed with repellent while outdoors. Avoid mosquitos by limiting time outdoors between dawn and dusk. Remember to spray your yard and get rid of any standing water.

***** **COMPOST SITE** *****

**** COMPOST SITE: DUE TO VIOLATIONS** - There will be a gate put across the entrance of the compost site. You will only be able to use the compost site when the gates are open from 8:00 am ó 10:00 pm. Times are subject to change. The compost site is not a dump or a landfill and **CANNOT** be treated like one. **Do not leave trash bags at the compost site.** It is a collection site for tree branches and grass clippings only. **Absolutely NO** lumber may be left at the compost site. Make sure to keep the piles separate. (Tree branches in the tree pile/grass in the grass pile.) Citations may be issued because we are at risk of losing it. Please contact the Village Office if you see any illegal dumping. A description of the vehicle and a license plate number would be a big help. The Compost site is open to Ceresco Water users only. **PLEASE DO NOT DRIVE IN THE COMPOST SITE WHEN IT IS MUDDY.**

****GARBAGE PICKUP AND RECYCLING:** Please make sure your toter is out the night before pickup and have the handle pointed in towards your house. They have a new truck with an arm that lifts the toter and dumps it.

**** CARDBOARD:** The dumpster at the Village Maintenance Shop is for **CARDBOARD ONLY**. Please **break down** boxes. No carpet or other items allowed.

**** METAL:** The metal box is for **METAL ONLY**. No mattresses, couches or other trash. The dumpsters will be removed if violations continue. **THE DUMPSTERS ARE FOR VILLAGE RESIDENTS ONLY.**
