\*\* VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR ANNUAL CERESCO CLEAN UP DAY: The annual Ceresco Cleanup Day will be Saturday, June 8 from 8:00 am - noon at the maintenance yard, 1<sup>st</sup> and Oak. Tires will NOT be accepted. Volunteers are always needed and appreciated, please contact the Village Office, if you can help. Dongt forget your gloves! Seniors and those with transportation issues please contact the Village Office before noon Friday, June 7<sup>th</sup>.

**\*\* RED CROSS BLOOD DRIVE:** There will be a Red Cross Blood Drive at the Ceresco Community Center on Saturday, June 8<sup>th</sup> from 7:30 am ó 1:30 pm. Contact Tyler at tymasek01@gmail.com, call 1-800-REDCROSS or visit RedCrossBlood.org and enter: CERESCONEB to schedule an appointment.

\*\* PET LICENSES ARE PAST DUE. Pets must be licensed EVERY YEAR by May 1<sup>st</sup>. The cost of the license is \$10.00 for dogs and \$3.00 for cats that are spayed/neutered and \$5.00 for cats that are not spayed or neutered. There is a limit of 3 dogs and 3 cats per residence. Please license your pets ASAP. Also, chicken permits are required annually. The permit cost is \$1.00. IT IS THE PET OWNERS' responsibility to keep their pet off other people property whether it a dog or cat. DO NOT let your pet defecate on others property or on the sidewalk (chapter 3 article 2 section 2-213). PLEASE, CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET.

**\*\*** WITH WARMER WEATHER coming and people leaving their windows open, barking dog complaints always rise. Please be considerate of your neighbors and keep your dog quiet. Everyone has different sleep schedules and daytime sleepers have a difficult time when people leave their dogs outside all day while they are at work and not there to monitor them. Dogs should be fenced in or kept on a leash or tied up when outside.

\*\* **POLICE CLUB:** A club for kids interested in Police work, crime scene investigation and evidence collection and more, will have a Police Dog demonstration at Ceresco Community Building on Monday, June 17<sup>th</sup> from noon 6 1:30 pm. **FREE** lunch will be provided for those who pre-register by June 14<sup>th</sup>, by emailing <u>cerescopolice@gmail.com</u>.

**\*\* MOSQUITO REMINDER:** Mosquitos carry the West Nile Virus. Ways to reduce risk of exposure are to apply insect repellent, cover up by wearing long sleeve shirts long pants and socks sprayed with repellent while outdoors. Avoid mosquitos by limiting time outdoors between dawn and dusk. Remember to spray your yard and get rid of any standing water.

**\*\* COMMENTS, CONCERNS, and COMPLAINTS:** Please call the Village Office 402-665-2391 if you have any comments, concerns or complaints. Or go to <u>www.cerescone.com</u> and click on Comments, Concerns, Complaints button and fill out the form and click submit. Please allow 48 hours for a response.

\*\* **FIRE PITS:** There is a code regulating fires and fire pits in town, please contact the Village Office for details.

\*\* **BUILDING PERMITS**: Many home/property improvements including fences, sidewalks, driveways, swimming pools, sheds car ports, ETC. require building permits. Please contact the Village Office with any questions.

**\*\*HELP US:** Take care of our parks and playgrounds-please supervise your children and remind them to take care of equipment, bathrooms, etc., and throw their trash away. Adults, please help monitor unattended children on the playground. Please report any suspicious behavior as soon as possible. **Both parks close at 10 PM.** 

\*\* **STREET LIGHTS:** If you see street lights not working, please call the Village Office and leave a message stating the location of the light that is out. Or you can visit <u>www.OPPD.com</u>, go to outages, and then click on report street light problem.

\*\* **COVENANT COMMUNITY FOOD PANTRY:** Is a food program for ANYONE in the community. It will be held the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays each month from 9:00 ó 10:00 A.M, at the Evangelical Covenant Church 208 W Pine. Enter through the East door and come to the kitchen. \*\* COMPOST SITE: Is not a dump or a landfill and CANNOT be treated like one. <u>Do not leave trash bags at the compost site</u>. It is a collection site for tree branches and grass clippings only. Absolutely NO lumber may be left at the compost site. Make sure to keep the piles separate. (Tree branches in the tree pile/grass in the grass pile.) Citations may be issued because we are at risk of losing it. Please contact the Village Office if you see any illegal dumping. A description of the vehicle and a license plate number would be a big help. The Compost site is open to Ceresco Water users only. PLEASE DO NOT DRIVE IN THE COMPOST SITE WHEN IT IS MUDDY.

\*\* **CARDBOARD:** The dumpster at the Village Maintenance Shop is for **CARDBOARD ONLY**. Please <u>break down</u> boxes. No carpet or other items allowed.

\*\* METAL: The metal box is for METAL ONLY. No mattresses, couches or other trash. The dumpsters will be removed if violations continue. THE DUMPSTERS ARE FOR VILLAGE RESIDENTS ONLY.
