**** SEWER RATES** are based on the water used during the months of December January and February. Please, fix dripping faucets and leaking toilets now to prevent higher sewer rates. Check your water softeners to make sure they are working properly.

**** YEARLY LICENSING REQUIREMENT:** Dogs and Cats must be licensed by **May 1 EVERY YEAR**. A proof of rabies vaccination is needed at the time of licensing. **Golf Carts, ATV/UTVs and Low Speed Vehicles** must also be licensed by May 1st. Proof of insurance is needed at the time of licensing.

***** WINTER WEATHER REMINDERS *****

**** PLEASE OBSERVE THESE WINTER WEATHER REMINDERS:**

- **DO NOT** Park on the street if there is snow.
- Make sure sidewalks are cleared of snow in a timely manner. **DO NOT BLOW OR SCOOP SNOW INTO THE STREET**
- **WATCH FACEBOOK** and www.cerescone.com for snow emergency information.
- Listen to radio station **106.3, KFOR, KFRX, the BLAZE, and EAGLE 92** or watch TV station **10/11, FOX 42, or Channel 7** for announcements of a snow emergency.
- In the event a snow emergency is declared, **ALL VEHICLES MUST BE MOVED OFF THE VILLAGE STREETS** until the snow emergency expires. Parking for vehicles that will not fit in personal driveways is available at the owners risk at either Immanuel Lutheran Church or Ceresco United Methodist Church parking lots. Vehicles must be removed from those parking lots immediately after the snow emergency expires.
- **VILLAGE SNOW REMOVAL:** Snow removal will begin with the business districts and main roadways and then move to residential areas. **Please keep vehicles off the streets to allow the Maintenance Personnel to do the best possible job of clearing snow.**
- **RESIDENT SNOW REMOVAL:** All sidewalks, with the exception of those sidewalks immediately adjacent to the paved portion of a street, shall be cleaned within five hours after the cessation of a storm unless the storm or snowfall has taken place during the night, in which case the sidewalk shall be cleaned before 8:30 a.m. the following day. Sidewalks located immediately adjacent to a paved street shall be cleaned within two hours after the village's snow plow has removed the snow from the adjacent paved street.

***** COMPOST REMINDERS *****

Open 8 am – 8 pm (WEATHER PERMITTING)
PICK UP TRASH BEFORE MOWING

DO NOT LEAVE PET FECES – even in bags
DO NOT LEAVE BAGS OF ANY KIND
DO NOT LEAVE ASHES

Any violations may cause the Village to be fined up to \$10,000 and be subject to closure.
