SEVERE WEATHER WEEK: March 27th – 31st is Sever Weather Week, and state wide tornado drill will be held on Wednesday, March 29th at approximately 10:00 am. Terry Miller the Emergency Management Coordinator will be sponsoring a storm spotting class on March 22nd at 7:00 pm all citizens are invited. Training will be in the law enforcement center tr4aining room 387 N Chestnut, Wahoo. REMINDER: download or update your ALERT SENCE app Saunders County's mass notification system.

LEGION STEAK FEED: Ceresco Legion Post 244 will be holding a steak feed on Saturday, March 11th. An 8oz choice top sirloin dinner with baked potato, hot vegetable and coffee or tea will be served starting at 5:30 pm. Hamburger night will be held on March 25th also starting at 5:30 pm.

SEWER RATES are based on the water used during the months of December January and February. New sewer rates will be reflected on the April bill.

YEARLY LICENSING REQUIREMENT: Dogs and Cats must be licensed by May 1 EVERY YEAR. A proof of rabies vaccination is needed at the time of licensing. Golf Carts, ATV/UTVs and Low Speed Vehicles must also be licensed by May 1st. Proof of insurance is needed at the time of licensing. Chicken permits are also required.

PLEASE OBSERVE THESE WINTER WEATHER REMINDERS:

- DO NOT Park on the street if there is snow.
- Make sure sidewalks are cleared of snow in a timely manner. DO NOT BLOW OR SCOOP SNOW INTO THE STREET
- WATCH FACEBOOK and <u>www.cerescone.com</u> for snow emergency information.
- Listen to radio station 106.3, KFOR, KFRX, the BLAZE, and EAGLE 92 or watch TV station 10/11, FOX 42, or Channel 7 for announcements of a snow emergency.
- In the event a snow emergency is declared, ALL VEHICLES MUST BE MOVED OFF THE VILLAGE STREETS
 until the snow emergency expires. Parking for vehicles that will not fit in personal driveways is available at the
 owners risk at either Immanuel Lutheran Church or Ceresco United Methodist Church parking lots. Vehicles must
 be removed from those parking lots immediately after the snow emergency expires.
- VILLAGE SNOW REMOVAL: Snow removal will begin with the business districts and main roadways and then
 move to residential areas. Please keep vehicles off the streets to allow the Maintenance Personnel to do the
 best possible job of clearing snow.
- RESIDENT SNOW REMOVAL: All sidewalks, with the exception of those sidewalks immediately adjacent to the
 paved portion of a street, shall be cleaned within five hours after the cessation of a storm unless the storm or
 snowfall has taken place during the night, in which case the sidewalk shall be cleaned before 8:30 a.m. the following
 day. Sidewalks located immediately adjacent to a paved street shall be cleaned within two hours after the village's
 snow plow has removed the snow from the adjacent paved street.
