 - **DO NOT** Park on the street if there is snow.
 - Make sure sidewalks are cleared of snow in a timely manner **DO NOT** blow or scoop snow into the street.
 - Listen to radio station 106.3, KFOR, KFRX, the BLAZE, and EAGLE 92 or watch TV station 10/11, FOX 42, or Channel 7 for announcements of a snow emergency. In the event a snow emergency is declared, ALL VEHICLES MUST BE MOVED OFF THE VILLAGE STREETS until the snow emergency expires. Parking for vehicles that will not fit in personal driveways is available at the owners risk at either Immanuel Lutheran Church or Ceresco United Methodist Church parking lots. Vehicles must be removed from those parking lots immediately after the snow emergency expires.

** COVENANT COMMUNITY FOOD PANTRY: Is a food program for ANYONE in the community. It will be held the 2nd and 4th Saturdays each month from 9:00 ó 10:00 A.M, at the Evangelical Covenant Church 208 W Pine. Enter through the East door and come to the kitchen. Local delivery available. If you have questions please call 402-785-5455 or 402-890-9850 and leave a message. They will get back to you.

** COMPOST SITE: DUE TO VIOLATIONS - A gate has been placed across the entrance of the compost site. If the gate is locked PLEASE DO NOT DUMP grass, tree branches, leaves or anything else AT THE GATE come back when it is open! You will only be able to use the compost site when the gates are open from 8:00 am ó 8:00 pm. Times are subject to change. The compost site is not a dump or a landfill and CANNOT be treated like one. Do not leave trash bags at the compost site. It is a collection site for tree branches and grass clippings only. Absolutely NO lumber may be left at the compost site. Make sure to keep the piles separate. (Tree branches in the tree pile/grass in the grass pile.) Citations may be issued because we are at risk of losing it. Please contact the Village Office if you see any illegal dumping. A description of the vehicle and a license plate number would be a big help. The Compost site is open to Ceresco Water users only. PLEASE DO NOT DRIVE IN THE COMPOST SITE WHEN IT IS MUDDY.

**GARBAGE PICKUP AND RECYCLING: <u>Please make sure your toter is out the night before pickup</u> and have the handle pointed in towards your house. They have a new truck with an arm that lifts the toter and dumps it. Also, please make sure there your toter isnot close to any vehicles so the arm can pick up the toter.

PLEASE NOTE! THE RECYCLING CONTAINERS IN THE MAINTENANCE YARD ARE FOR CERESCO UTILITY CUSTOMERS ONLY!

** **CARDBOARD:** The dumpster at the Village Maintenance Shop is for **CARDBOARD ONLY**. Please <u>break down</u> boxes. No carpet or other items allowed.

** METAL: The metal box is for METAL ONLY. No mattresses, couches or other trash. The dumpsters will be removed if violations continue. THE DUMPSTERS ARE FOR VILLAGE RESIDENTS ONLY.
