\*\*\*\*\* WINTER WEATHER REMINDERS \*\*\*\*\*

\*\* PARK BATHROOMS ARE CLOSED: The bathrooms at the park have been winterized and will remain locked until spring.

\*\* VILLAGE SNOW REMOVAL: Snow removal will begin with the business districts and main roadways, then move to residential areas. Vehicles should be kept off the streets as much as possible to allow the Maintenance Personnel to do the best possible job of clearing snow.

\*\* RESIDENTIAL SNOW REMOVAL: All sidewalks, with the exception of those sidewalks immediately adjacent to the paved portion of a street, shall be cleaned within five hours after the cessation of a storm unless the storm or fall of snow shall have taken place during the night, in which case the sidewalk shall be cleaned before 8:30 a.m. the following day. Sidewalks located immediately adjacent to a paved street shall be cleaned within two hours after the village's snow plow has removed the snow from the adjacent paved street. (Neb. Rev. \*\* REGULAR LIBRARY HOURS: The library will be open from 10 am – noon and 2:30 – 7:00 pm Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and 10:00 am – 3:00 pm on Saturday.

\*\* WATCH FOR CHILDREN playing outside, walking to school, and riding bikes. Many times they forget to watch for you. PLEASE drive carefully, obey the speed limit and watch for children. DO NOT PASS SCHOOL A BUS WITH THE STOP ARM OUT!

\*\* PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE of your neighbors and keep your dog quiet. Dogs should be fenced in, kept on a leash, or tied up when outside.

\*\* PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR HOUSE NUMBER IS VISIBLE FROM THE STREET IN CASE EMERGENCY PERSONNEL NEEDS TO FIND YOU. House numbers should be contrast with the background and be a minimum of 4" high and 1/2" in width. Numbers should not be spelled out.
