**** PRIMARY ELECTION:** Will still be held in the Community Building on May 12th.

**** THE VILLAGE OFFICE IS CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC:** Burn permits, Pet Licenses, Utility Applications, and Building Permits can be obtained by calling the Village Office 402-665-2391 or emailing jlindgren@ceresccone.com or cerescoutilities@gmail.com. **Payments** can be dropped in the box or made online by going to the website www.cerescone.com and clicking on **PAY MY BILL** you will need your account number to pay your bill online. There will be no change given for cash payments until further notice. Please note if you wish to pay with cash have the exact change otherwise the extra will be credited to your utility account.

**** UNION SERVICE FUND:** Is a community fund to help people in crisis. If you would like to donate to the Union Service Fund you can mail a check to Ceresco Evangelical Covenant Church P.O. Box 180 Ceresco, NE 68017 with a note of **UNION SERVICE FUND** in the memo.

**** PET LICENSES ARE DUE MAY 1st.** Pets must be licensed EVERY YEAR by May 1st, the cost of the license is \$10.00 for dogs and \$3.00 for cats that are spayed/neutered and \$5.00 for cats that are not spayed or neutered. There is a limit of 3 dogs and 3 cats per residence. Please license your pets ASAP. Also, chicken permits are required annually. The permit cost is \$1.00. **REMINDER: Roosters are not allowed in town.**

**\*\* IT IS THE PET OWNERS' responsibility** to keep their pet off other people's property whether it's a dog or cat. **DO NOT** let your pet defecate on others property (chapter 3 article 2 section 2-213). **PLEASE, CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR PET.**

**** PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE** of your neighbors and keep your dog quiet. Everyone has different sleep schedules and daytime sleepers have a difficult time when people leave their dogs outside all day while they are at work and not there to monitor them. Dogs should be fenced, in or kept on a leash, or tied up when outside.

**** REMINDER FROM THE POLICE DEPARTMENT:** Please do not leave valuables in your vehicles and make sure to keep vehicles and garage doors locked.

**** VILLAGE CARDBOARD RECYCLING DUMPSTER at 1st & OAK: Is for CERESCO UTILITY CUSTOMERS ONLY. If you use the cardboard dumpster please make sure you **BREAK DOWN THE BOXES!****

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR HOUSE NUMBER IS VISIBLE FROM THE STREET IN CASE EMERGENCY PERSONNEL NEEDS TO FIND YOU. House numbers should be contrast with the background and be a minimum of 4" high and 1/2" in width. Numbers should not be spelled out.

**** AA MEETINGS:** are held on Sunday nights at 8:00 in the Community Building.

REMINDER TO ANYONE RENTING THE COMMUNITY BUILDING; THE 10 PERSON – 6' APART MANDATE STILL NEEDS TO BE FOLLOWED.

**** RECYCLING CHANGE:** The recycling company no longer collects glass, please do not put glass in your recycling toter. Here is an updated list of what they do accept.

- **Aluminum and tin** - rinse out all food and beverage containers, aluminum containers (disposable pie plates), and clean aluminum foil/tin cans and aluminum cans.
- **Aerosol cans and paint cans** - (hairspray or deodorant) **MUST BE EMPTY!** Paint cans **MUST** have paint removed.
- **Paper** – newspaper, magazines, brown grocery bags, telephone books, catalog, office paper, mail, envelopes, chipboard (cereal boxes) wet strength carrier stock (12 pack beverage box) frozen food packages, juice boxes.
- **Plastic** – plastic containers 1 through 7, numbers are on bottom of container. Please rinse out.
- **Cardboard** – please **BREAK DOWN** or cut up so they are flat and no longer than 2x2' – if it won't fit inside the toter **PLEASE** place it under the toter so it doesn't blow around.

***** **COMPOST SITE** *****

**** COMPOST SITE:** Open 8:00 am – dark. Due to violations a gate has been placed across the entrance of the compost site. If the gate is locked **PLEASE DO NOT DUMP** grass, tree branches, leaves or anything else **at the gate**. Come back when it is open! You will only be able to use the compost site when the gates are open. **Times are subject to change.** The compost site is not a dump or a landfill and **CANNOT** be treated like one. **Do not leave trash bags at the compost site.** It is a collection site for tree branches and grass clippings only. **Absolutely NO** lumber may be left at the compost site. Make sure to keep the piles separate. (Tree branches in the tree pile/grass in the grass pile.) Citations may be issued because we are at risk of losing it. Please contact the Village Office if you see any illegal dumping. A description of the vehicle and a license plate number would be a big help. The Compost site is open to Ceresco Water users only. **PLEASE DO NOT DRIVE IN THE COMPOST SITE WHEN IT IS MUDDY.**
