**\*\* A FRIENDLY REMINDER:** The extension Governor Ricketts mandated on registering vehicles is coming to an end August 31<sup>st</sup>. Vehicles with expired license plates can be ticketed. Please register your vehicle to prevent being fined for invalid plates.

**\*\* LIBRARY HOURS:** Will return to normal starting September 1<sup>st</sup>. The library will be open from 10 am – noon and 2:30 – 7:00 pm Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and 10:00 am – 3:00 pm on Saturday.

**\*\* DONATIONS:** If you have books to donate to the library please call 402-665-2112 during business hours before dropping them off.

**\*\* BUILDING PERMIT REMINDER:** Many home/property improvements including decks, fences, sidewalks, driveways, swimming pools, sheds, car ports, retaining walls, ETC require building permits. Please call the Village Office before starting ANY home improvement project to see if a permit is needed.

**\*\* PLEASE KEEP YOUR YARD MOWED:** It can be declared a public nuisance if your yard is not maintained properly and fines may occur. **DO NOT BLOW GRASS INTO THE STREET!!!**

**\*\* UNION SERVICE FUND:** Is a community fund to help people in crisis. If you would like to donate to the Union Service Fund you can mail a check to Ceresco Evangelical Covenant Church, P.O. Box 180, Ceresco, NE 68017 with a note of **UNION SERVICE FUND** in the memo.

**\*\* WATCH FOR CHILDREN** playing outside, walking to school, and riding bikes, many times they forget to watch for you. **PLEASE** drive carefully, obey the speed limit and watch for children. **DO NOT PASS SCHOOL BUSES WITH THE STOP ARM OUT!**

**\*\* PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE** of your neighbors and **keep your dog quiet**. Everyone has different sleep schedules and daytime sleepers have a difficult time when people leave their dogs outside all day while they are at work and not there to monitor them. Dogs should be fenced, in or kept on a leash, or tied up when outside.

**\*\* PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR HOUSE NUMBER IS VISIBLE FROM THE STREET IN CASE EMERGENCY PERSONNEL NEEDS TO FIND YOU.** House numbers should be contrast with the background and be a minimum of 4” high and 1/2” in width. Numbers should not be spelled out.

**\*\* COMPOST SIT REMINDERS:**

- Open 8:00 am – dark
- DO NOT LEAVE PET FECES – even in bags
- Keep Piles Separate
  - Trees in tree pile
  - Grass in grass pile
- Do Not Leave Trash in Grass Clippings – Pick up trash before mowing
- DO NOT LEAVE BAGS OF ANY KIND
- DO NOT LEAVE ASHES

Any violations may cause the Village to be fined up to \$10,000 and be subject to closure.
